Demi Pair Program Terms & Conditions

The student selected by the Host Family will assist the family with day-to-day child care and light housework, for a period not to exceed 4 hours per day for a maximum of 15 hours per week. In exchange of the housework the student will receive full board (3 meals x 7 days) and lodging (own private room). The minimum study and Demi Pair application is 12 weeks or more (minimum Intermediate level of English required).

Work Contract

The Demi Pair application is only available to students on Working Holiday and Student Visas.

As a Demi Pair you will need to assist with general housework and the children. Here are examples of tasks that your family may require you to do and that you will be expected to do - ironing, laundry, vacuuming, washing floors, dusting, cleaning toilets and bathrooms, cooking meals, in addition to keeping your own room tidy. In the mornings you may be expected to wake the children, help them get dressed and ready for school and take them to school. In the evenings, duties may include bringing them home from school, giving them a bath and their dinner and getting them ready for bed. We suggest that if there is something in the above you cannot do, ask someone to teach you before coming to Australia.

If you wish to finish the program early, you must give 15 business days notice to Impact English College so the family can be informed.

Host Family Obligations

The Host Family agrees to provide the student with:

- A written agreement for the duration, signed by both parties prior to start date in line with role agreed with Australian Demi Pair
- A warm welcome as part of the family
- Time to settle in, with guidance, training and support
- The Host Family is to discuss the house rules, expectations and Demi Pair duties with the student
- Clear written guidance on what is expected in line with role agreed with Australian Demi Pair
- Full board and a fully furnished room for the student's exclusive use
- Time-off and support to attend appropriate language classes where applicable
- At least two full free days off per week for the student. Flexibility of hours can be negotiated with the host family
- The Host Family need to give permission and be notified before inviting friends over
- Driving assessment and lessons if the student is required to drive;

- access to insured and safe vehicle
- Pocket money for extra help (when it exceeds 15 hours per week)

Both the Host Family and the student are required to communicate to each other, as good communication is essential.

Background Information

For the purpose of facilitating placement the student is required to complete a Working with Children (Blue Card) application and obtain a police clearance from country of origin in English or with an accredited translation.

Cancellations

The program fee will be refunded for cancellations received 30 days prior to the student's scheduled arrival in Australia less an administrative fee of \$100. No refund will be given to the student where a notice of cancellation is given less than 30 days prior to the scheduled arrival in Australia. All requests for refunds must be made in writing.

Dismissal without required notice, breach of contract or misconduct by the Host Family will result in any costs incurred by the student or by Australian Demi Pair on the student's behalf to be paid by the Host Family (e.g. accommodation, and transportation).

Expenses

All costs associated with passports, visas, travel and medical insurance are to be paid by the student.
