<p>For direct entry into programs normally requiring an IELTS 5.5 entry, a student of Impact English College must successfully complete either:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •A minimum of 10 weeks of study in IELTS/EAP at Upper Intermediate Level •A minimum of 10 weeks of study in Cambridge B2 First (FCE)
<p>For direct entry into programs normally requiring an IELTS 6.0 entry, a student of Impact English College must successfully complete either:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •A minimum of 10 weeks of study in IELTS/EAP at Advanced Level •A minimum of 10 weeks of study in Cambridge C1 Advanced (CAE)
<p>For direct entry into programs normally requiring an IELTS 6.5 entry, a student of Impact English College must successfully complete either:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •A minimum of 15 weeks of study in IELTS/EAP at Advanced Level •A minimum of 10 weeks of study in Cambridge C1 Advanced (CAE)

- Students who fail to meet the academic and/or attendance requirements of an Impact course may be required to complete a further 5 weeks of study.
- A student who tests above the entry level for an Impact course will be required to complete a minimum of 5 weeks of study in an appropriate level.
